In reflection on the message for Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> March 2023

Extracts from Matthew 20, v20-28, A Mother's Request.
v20f: Then the mother of Zebedee's sons came to Jesus with her sons
and, kneeling down, asked a favour of him.
She said, "Grant that one of my sons may sit at your right
and the other at your left in the kingdom."
v23f: Jesus said, "You will drink from my cup, but the places beside me

belong to those for whom have been prepared by my Father." v24: The disciples were indignant with the two brothers.
But Jesus told the disciples:

v26f: "Whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant, and whoever wants to be first must be your slave ----- just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom or many."

Sermon for Passion Sunday: Serving Others.

The reading reminds us that Jesus was The Servant King. We were born with the gifts which God gave us. Our God-given gifts should be used to serve others.
